



Basic Guide to emigrate to UK

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Hello everyone!

I am Javi, spanish nutritionist currently working in the NHS (british public health system), specialised in Surgery and Oncology. With over **5yearsofexperience** I am head of deparment in a hospital near London.

In UK, the profession of “dietitian” is considered to be in “**shortage**”, this means it is in crisis due to lack of staff, this is why NHS is hiring **internationally**.

Salary starts in over **£2650/month** and can get over **£10000/month**, with really good working conditions, **quickprogression**, **permanentcontracts** and the possibility to **specialise** in multiple areas (Pediatrics, Oncology, Intensive Care...)

Requirements

In order to be able to work in UK as a nutritionist/dietitian. You must meet a few simple requirements. It is not necessary to have previous work experience, which really helps if you recently graduated.

- **University degree** in human nutrition
- **Medium** level of english.
- **Previous experience is not required**

Process (3 steps)

1. Paperwork (HCPC)

First step is to get **registered in HCPC**, this is the organisation that regulates healthcare professionals in UK. You will have to gather and submit basic documentation, it is **essential** to do it **correctly**, in order to avoid delays or rejections.

- Identity and address
- University title/degree
- English Certificate

2. 📄 CV + cover letter

Once you have your HCPC registration, you can start applying for jobs completely online. It is **essential** to adapt your CV to the British format, as well as elaborating a high quality cover letter, this really makes you stand out in order to get called to interviews.

- British CV format
- High quality and mandatory Cover letter
- Online applications (you can do it from home)

3. 🗣️ Interviews

Once you start applying, you will start getting called to interviews (if you have adapted your CV and have done a proper Cover letter). Their structure is quite standard, therefore we can prepare it well.

- 6–12 questions
- ~45 minutes
- Generally online format. (Through Videocall)

If you are the best candidate and you get the job, the employer will sponsor you for your **Visa**, which can be processed online.

 **Results**

Following these steps, it is absolutely possible getting a well paid job here, permanent contract and with good stability. However, you must follow the process correctly in order to reach your goal.
